Candidate's statements and photographs (to be published in Vertigo) must be submitted with the nomination forms and in soft copy form in the required format by the close of nominations.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE AT 2:00PM FRIDAY 1 October 2021 NOMINATIONS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME

Nominations must be emailed to the Returning Officer no later than 2pm Friday 1 October 2021.

Group Nominations (Lists/Tickets)

Group nominations are possible where there is more than one position available for a particular office, ie for Student Representative Councillors and NUS, and is required for Editors of Vertigo

A person can only be elected to 1 position on the UTSSA, but may nominate for multiple positions. Where applicable, the candidate must email the Returning Officer stating their order of preference for the positions. Persons can be elected to both the UTSSA and NUS, as these are different elections

The Draw for positions on the ballot paper will be held at 1pm on Wednesday 3 October at the Returning Officers Office. Students may view the Draw via ZOOM. The Zoom link will be published on facebook and the website after nominations close.

This will be followed by an information session (continuation of the Zoom session) where questions can be answered.

Voting will be on-line again this year due to continuing COVID restrictions, using the Universities system. Students will be emailed a link, and will log in using their normal credentials.
