Women's Officer to be elected by and from students who have lived experience as a woman

International Students' Officer to be elected by and from students who hold an Overseas Student Visa

14 Student Representative Councillors

7 Delegates to the National Union of Students

Vertigo Editorial Team (of between 6 and 12 students)

Nominations must be submitted on the prescribed form which may be obtained from the Returning Officer or at <https://utsstudentsassociation.org.au/elections> Each candidate requires 3 nominators.

Candidate's statements and photographs (to be published in Vertigo) must be submitted with the nomination forms and in soft copy form in the required format by the close of nominations.

NOMINATIONS CLOSE AT 2:00PM TUESDAY 20 SEPTEMBER 2022

NOMINATIONS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME

Nominations must be emailed to the Returning Officer no later than 2pm Tuesday 20 September 2022 or alternatively, may be received at the Association Office at Broadway, from 12 noon to 2pm on Tuesday 20 September 2022. Soft copies of photos and statements are also required

Group Nominations (Lists/Tickets)

Group nominations are possible where there is more than one position available for a particular office, ie for Student Representative Councillors and NUS, and is required for Editors of Vertigo

A person can only be elected to 1 position on the UTSSA, but may nominate for multiple positions. Where applicable, the candidate must email the Returning Officer stating their order of preference for the positions. Persons can be elected to both the UTSSA and NUS, as these are different elections

The Draw for positions on the ballot paper will be held at 1pm on Thursday 22 September at the Student Association's office. This will be followed by an information session where questions can be answered.

This year voting will revert to the usual On-Campus In-Person style.

Polling booths will be located in at least 5 buildings around the campus and be open from 10.30 to 1.30pm and again from 3.30pm until 6.30 pm.

Postal Voting is available for any member who will be absent from campus during voting times. The Application must be received by the close of nominations. Forms are available on the UTSSA website.
